Midwinter Tour

- Day 1 Arrival at Kiruna airport. The guide will meet you at the airport and accompany you to the wilderness camp in Väkkärjärvi or directly at our kennel. Here you will meet the dogs and become acquainted with the camp and its surroundings. Dinner.
- Day 2 We start the day by watering the dogs, after which we will eat breakfast. After breakfast we will learn the basics on how to handle the dogs, sleds and harnesses. We will then pack the sleds with all the necessary items for the coming days. As soon as the preparations are ready, we will set off on the tour.
Each participant will drive his or her own sled with a team of four dogs, following the guide who will lead the way. On arrival at the next camp, we will work together to prepare both the dogs and ourselves for the night. This will include feeding of the dogs, chopping wood and fetching water. We end the day with dinner and a sauna.
- Day 3 We start the day by watering the dogs, after which we will eat breakfast. We will drive between 25 and 50 kilometres per day, and sleep in chalets along the route.
- Day 4 The morning routines are the same every day. The rest of the day is characterized by the route chosen. Our tour takes us through Europe's last remaining wilderness, where we will experience the Northern Lights in the dark polar night, glittering white snow during the day, pure air, and a silence so intense you can almost hear it.
- Day 5 The landscape will vary considerably depending on the route we choose to take. The routes will lead us along rivers, through thick forests and mountain ranges, and across lakes.
- Day 6 In the event of bad weather, an alternative day itinerary can be included. The day could be spent, for instance, sightseeing in Kiruna. At some point during the tour we will also try to visit the world famous Ice Hotel in Jukkasjärvi, Each person paying (Apx: 30 Euro) themselves if they want to walk in to Icehotel.
- Day 7 All overnighting will take place in chalets along the trails. It will be up to the guide to decide which chalets we stay in and what routes we follow. Back at husky farm, all dogs back in kennels there they belongs, dinner.
- Day 8 Breakfast and after that you will be driven to Airport for your flight home

Please note: This is a preliminary itinerary. The length and route of the tour may vary depending on circumstances beyond our control such as weather, trail access, and seasonal variations and also where we have bigger reindeer herds at the moment.
